

EMPOWERING WOMEN IN ASSAM: SOWING SEEDS OF CHANGE



Citizens Foundation HRDP Tamulpur, with support of HDFC Bank Parivartan, has undertaken an initiative to empower women in two specific regions of Assam. This project involved the distribution of kitchen garden seeds and essential tools.



One distribution event was conducted in the Goreswar block, located within the Tamulpur district, while the other occurred in the Bihdia-Jajikona Block within the Kamrup district. It is worth highlighting the instrumental role played by Mr. Munindra Kakati, Assistant Agriculture Inspector in Tamulpur district, conducted an insightful on-field demonstration and provided invaluable training to the recipients, enhancing the success of this initiative.

HEALTH CAMP AT AAROGYA PROJECT, BOKARO



Citizens Foundation, in collaboration with District Health Committee, partnered with ESL Steel Limited under the Arogya Project to conduct a Health Camp near the Madhuniya Muslim Tola community hall, Bokaro.



The camp offered a range of health services, including child vaccinations, ANC (Antenatal Care) tests for pregnant women, anemia testing, and HIV screening. Additionally, a comprehensive general health check-up facility was made available to all participants. Vaccination of a total of 22 children, ANC test of 26 women, HIV test of 84 people and anemia test of 86 women and general health checkup of a total of 122 people were done, a total of 340 People were benefited with the Health Camp organized by Citizens Foundation under the AAROGYA Project.

NURTURING HEALTH AND WELLNESS: A MEETING FOR LACTATING AND PREGNANT MOTHERS



A Meeting was organized by Citizens Foundation under the project of ONGC Foundation at AWC Bagiyatola, Bokaro bringing together several participants, primarily lactating and pregnant mothers. The meeting focused on various crucial topics, including Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF), addressing malnutrition, Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM), and promoting the adoption of good hygiene practices in daily routines.

CASE STUDY

Making Gram Prashasan Kendra GPK Techno friendly

Overview :

The Gram Prashasan Kendra (GPK) which is also known as Panchayat office is a government institution which is responsible for maintaining the Gram Panchayat Units where the Panchayat President along with the team of Panchayat sits and work for the implementation of government schemes and other aspects at Gram Panchayat level. The said institution is working for the community and was also facing lack of infrastructure and digital connection which was internet as well as security conveniences like CCTV cameras. It needed support to become techno friendly along with an upgraded infrastructure so that it could cater to the community properly.

Outcome:

The HRDP Sikkim Citizens foundation supported by HDFC Parivartan took an initiative as per the demand of GPKs of two GPUs covered in project area to make the GPK techno friendly. This involved the following:


1. To provide furniture, cupboard, chair & tables, etc., along with shelves to maintain the documentation and administration aspects.
2. To installed CCTV Cameras in the premises for safety measures.
3. To installed Wi-Fi connection along with digital board of government schemes so that the regulated schemes are displayed over the screen for public interest.

Impact:

It is well known that government institutions are for public. We took a step to be for those government institutions so that they could cater the community more efficiently. Being a helping hand to the helper is again an achievement.
