Under the LIC Housing Finance Limited HRIDAY project, Citizens Foundation provided crucial food relief to 320 flood-affected families across several villages in Algapur Block, Hailakandi district, Assam. In response to the severe floods that disrupted lives and displaced communities, the initiative focused on supporting the most

vulnerable—women, children, and the elderly—by distributing freshly cooked, nutritious lunches. This timely intervention addressed immediate hunger while fostering a sense of care, solidarity, and trust between Citizens Foundation and the local communities during a time of great hardship.

## SBI SANJEEVANI MOBILE CLINIC LAUNCHED IN CHANDAN BLOCK, OF BANKA DISTRICT, BIHAR TO SERVE 40,000 PEOPLE IN 20 VILLAGES





The SBI Sanjeevani Clinic on Wheels, launched by Citizens Foundation in partnership with SBI Foundation and SBI Ventures, was officially flagged off in Chandan

Block, Banka District, B<mark>ihar—an aspirational and rem</mark>ote regi<mark>on—</mark>by Dr. Ashish, MOIC of

Chandan CHC, alongside the Citizens Foundation healthcare team. This mobile health initiative is set to serve around 40,000 people across 20 villages, delivering critical medical services to those with limited access to healthcare. Operated by Citizens Foundation, this marks the third of five Sanjeevani Clinics being rolled out to bridge healthcare gaps in underserved communities.





## CITIZENS FOUNDATION HANDS OVER ONGC-SUPPORTED ANGANWADI CENTRE IN ASSAM:

Marking a Key Milestone in Community-Led Childcare Development



Citizens Foundation successfully organized the handover ceremony

of the ONGC Foundation Centre supported Anganwadi (AWC) in Assam, as part of the project "Developing 75 Anganwadi Centres and Upskilling Anganwadi Workers to Ensure Nutritional Support and Sustainable Childhood Care" being implemented Jharkhand, across Nagaland, Assam, and Andhra Pradesh. The event marked a significant milestone in promoting community ownership strengthening early childhood care systems. Attended by over 200 participants, the program saw the presence of distinguished guests



including the GGM and Senior HR Executive from ONGC Limited, four CDPOs, two Supervisors, the VDC Chairman of Nazira, the Panchayat President, four VDC members, 12 AWC workers, and the Citizens Foundation team.

Marking a Boost to Rural Education in Tamulpur, Assam

## MRS. SOMARI MUNDAIN - TRANSFORMING AGRICULTURE THROUGH ORGANIC PRACTICES IN KHUNTI DIST, JHARKHAND

#### **Overview:**

Mrs. Somari Mundain is a dedicated farmer living in the Kudlum Panchayat of the Karra Block. With 15 decimals of land, she has always sought ways to improve her agricultural practices and increase her yield. After attending a series of training sessions organized by Citizens Foundation in collaboration with LTIMindtree Foundation, under Integrated Village Development Program. Mrs. Mundain's approach to farming underwent a significant transformation.

#### Outcome:

Following the training, Mrs. Mundain successfully adopted organic farming practices on her land. By using organic manure from her NADEP compost pit, she improved soil health, reduced reliance on chemical fertilizers, and lowered overall farming costs. As a result, she now grows healthier crops like chilies, potatoes, and tomatoes—benefiting both her family's nutrition and providing safer, eco-friendly produce to her customers.





#### **Impact:**

The results of Mrs. Mundain's efforts have been remarkable. By selling her organically grown vegetables in local markets, she has established a steady source of income. This newfound economic stability has allowed her to sustain her livelihood and support her family. Moreover, she now enjoys the peace of mind that comes from consuming chemical-free produce.
